- This week in Pre-School we have had a wonderful busy time...
- Our role play area was transformed into a space theme. The children have been dressing up as astronauts and going on space missions.
- The children have been very creative with making aliens, planets and mini astronauts with photos of themselves.
- In PE we had to follow simple instructions and played a variety of games that used our whole bodies.
- In music and movement this week we played ring games and sang a variety of nursery rhymes.
- Outside we went on a leaf hunt and the children were challenged with finding different sized and shaped leaves
- Diwali the festival of 'lights' has been celebrated this week – sharing stories, looking at Diwali parades, dancing, creating Rangoli patterns and making Diya lamps with clay and candles.
